BECKMAN GLASS ELECTRODE pH METER

A PORTABLE, SELF-CONTAINED, DIRECT READING INSTRUMENT FOR
FIELD, FACTORY AND LABORATORY USE

With a small, sturdy glass electrode intended for filling with HCl and quinhydrone, and employing a saturated calomel cell as reference. No chemicals are added to the unknown solution, only 2 ml of which is required for a reading.

Operates upon the well-known potentiometer principle. A vacuum tube amplifier operating as a null instrument is used in place of a galvanometer, making the instrument rugged and unaffected by vibration. Conveniently located controls permit rapid adjustment.

The dial is calibrated in pH units through the range of pH 0 to pH 12.5 in 0.1 pH divisions. These scale divisions permit estimation of readings to 0.01 pH. Because of the inherent characteristics of all glass electrode systems, an *overall accuracy* greater than 0.1 pH can not be expected without special precautions.

The temperature compensator is continuously adjustable in steps of 5° over the range 10 to 40°C. A zero adjustment is provided to compensate for changes in the asymmetry potential of the glass electrode. The walnut carrying case is 11 x 9 x 8 inches, with total weight less than 18 lbs. Closing the cover automatically shuts off the instrument and locks the door of the shielded electrode compartment.
